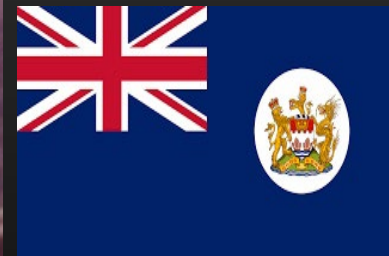

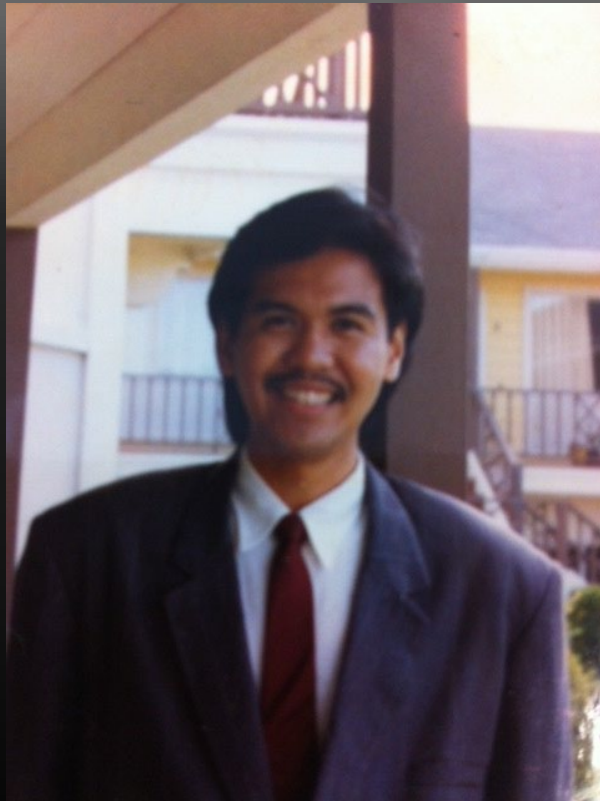


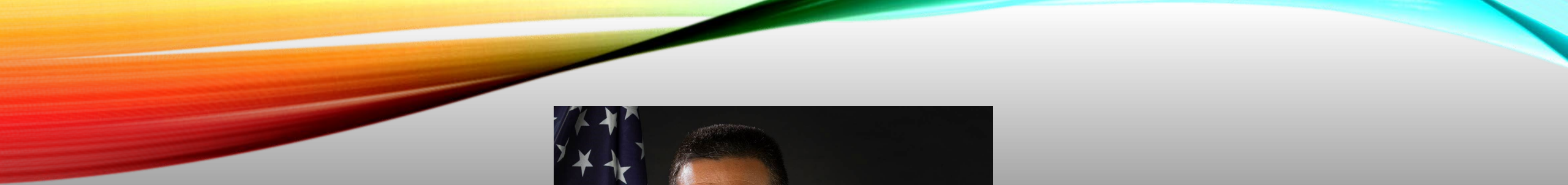

Pillar Six: *Officer Wellness & Safety*

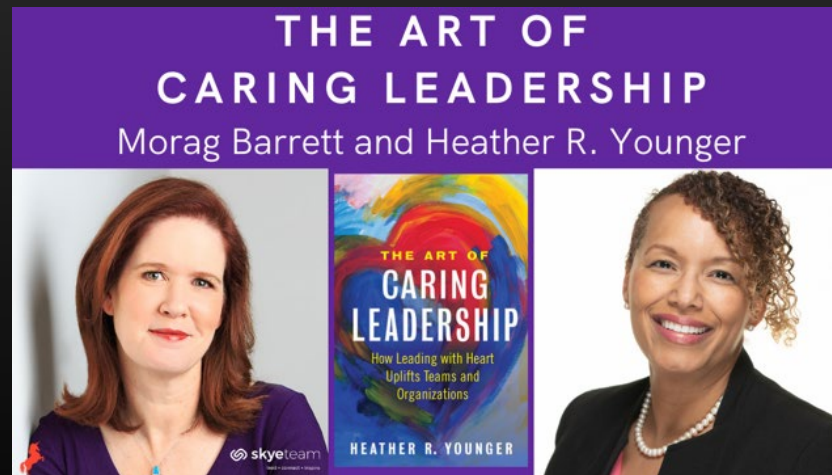
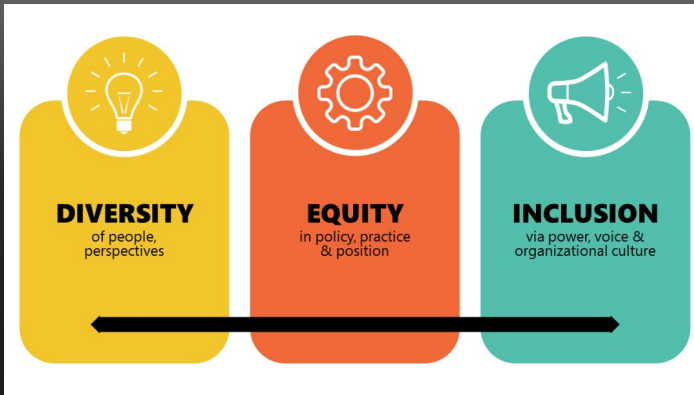


Challenge to continue finding the right people with the right mindset to be officers and employees of the Department

Partnerships that address mental health on Campus

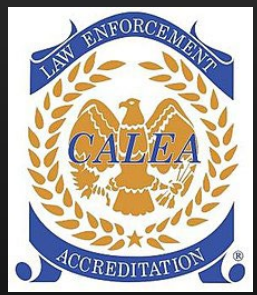
